
# Following the History of France, this is the first of a brilliant new series illustrated by Bruno Heitz.

What is Art? How did the earliest works come about? Why have some survived centuries, while others have been long forgotten? How did their creators live and work?

Accurate, vivid, full of details, brilliantly brought to life by Bruno Heitz, The History of Art in Graphic Novel is a vast journey through time exploring artistic creation, its works and their artists.

This first volume starts chronologically with prehistory (cave paintings, megaliths), and then Egypt, Greece and Ancient Rome. It continues with the Middle Ages (cathedrals) and finishes with the start of the Renaissance in Italy signalled by the arrival of the first great masters (Giotto, Botticelli...). Painting, sculpture and architecture are the three main areas this first volume covers.



We also learn about the school life of Manon D. and the boy who definitely makes her dream.






