Through her more than thirty books, Anne Herbauts has and continues to provide her readers a poetic and original universe, making of her one of the most talented illustrator of her generation. Even if you already know her books, each reading is a new and magical experience.

Sometimes Anne Herbauts explores other kinds of writing, in other margins, such as short films, animation movies, narrative spaces, huts. She collects moon splinters, shavings of images. and draws lack and emptiness through layouts of writing, through marks of recess, through stacking, repetition, stuttering. She likes short sentences and delectable words. She is too greedy. She is neither in the image, or in the text, yet in both at the same time. Between the two of them, the in-between, is her "working place". Time and books are her main working materials.




David Sala





The ineffable delicacy of the illustrations puts Atlas of the Geographers of Orbae in the category of fiction that describes - as if part of a dream world – the ardour, hopes and world vision of all great voyagers since time began. But this is not just an account of anthropological and geographical exploration. Imagination and fantasy are very much part of this gripping tale. The maps of the fictional countries visited give substance to an imaginary world. Not only a delight to the eye, places and patterns contribute to the knowledge adventure brings and a comforting awareness of human achievement.




François Place
